CCA'S HOUSING, LAND USE & DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE TO ADDRESS CITY'S ONEROUS RECOMMENDATIONS RE: DOWNTOWN INDUSTRIAL LAND

At a public workshop last night, the Los Angeles Planning Department and Community Redevelopment Agency (CRA) released their recommendations for the future use of Downtown's industrial land. CCA finds these recommendations, which advocate preserving a majority of Downtown's industrially-zoned land, onerous.

CCA will be forming a subcommittee on industrial land policy to address these recommendations and to determine CCA's course of action over the next several months. It is critical that this working group mobilize quickly, as Planning and CRA staff have indicated that they intend to take the recommendations to the Planning Commission in January, 2007.
