NEW PROPOSED PARKS FEE

This Wednesday, December 5th at 2:00 p.m., City Council's Arts, Parks, Health and Aging Committee will be considering a motion requesting LAHD and the Department of Recreation and Parks to develop a proposed fee to be charged to developers of new market rate apartments and condo conversions. This fee would be used to purchase open space, as well as fund existing parks. It is our understanding that this fee would be charged in addition to Quimby and other Recreation and Parks fees already charged to development.

We are currently working to find out more information and are requesting that this item be continued (especially in light of the recent controversy over Quimby fees). We will need a presence at the hearing tomorrow, which will take place:
